Through this pledge drive, any person, company or organization can make a pledge to the Survivor Fund for each tragedy-related payout. By doing so, the Survivor Fund is able to notify those who pledged when these tragedies occur, thus maintaining awareness within the industry and ensuring roadside safety remains in the discussions of towing companies nationwide. Additionally, the pledge drive allows the Survivor Fund to predict the amount that will come in from pledges associated with each event, which has allowed a continued increase in the benefits to industry families.
